For the 24th year, the graduates, parents, and friends of the U. S. Military, Naval, Coast Guard, Merchant Marine, and Air Force Academies will come together for their annual contest and gathering to claim the Challenge Trophy at the Ken Kronlund Classic. This year the Classic extends an invitation to all ROTC Graduates and Cadets as well as all military, veterans and friends. A new Open Trophy will be there for the winning team. The West Point Society of New England will again sponsor this year's golf outing and will contribute to the military charity we are sponsoring: the Patriot Resilient Leader Institute.

The event will return to the South Course of the Stow Acres Golf Club, 58 Randall Rd, Stow, MA 01775.

Shotgun start begins promptly at 0900. Registration begins at 0730.

## Format

Two-person teams will choose one of the following formats of play for their team.

- Nine holes of scramble and nine holes of best ball, declared hole by hole by each team after all golfers in the foursome have hit their tee shots,
  - Best Ball for all 18 holes (team will be awarded bonus points),
  - Scramble for all 18 holes (team will have points deducted).
- Scoring will be provided at the challenge.

1. The ALL ACADEMY CHALLENGE TROPHY is limited to teams consisting of graduates of the same academy.

2. The KEN KRONLUND CLASSIC OPEN TROPHY, INDIVIDUAL CHAMPION TROPHY and all other competition and recognition (longest drive & closest-to pin) is available to all golfers. The CHALLENGE TROPHY AND OPEN TROPHY will recognize the winning team and the runner up.

3. The 2016 KEN KRONLUND CLASSIC INDIVIDUAL CHAMPION TROPHY will be awarded to the player scoring the most points playing the Best Ball format.

4. Cost will be \$125 for each player, which includes: buffet lunch, green fees, cart, prizes, and one restricted mulligan. Each player may purchase a maximum of two unrestricted mulligans. Unrestricted mulligans must be purchased on line at registration.

The club house will be serving beverages available at the bar (credit card processing available) and on the course (cash - no host).

Hole sponsorship (\$100) is available to support Patriot Resilient Leader Institute.

**24th Annual All Academy Golf Challenge**  
**The Ken Kronlund Classic, 22 July 2016** *Rules*

- 1) **Challenge Trophy Team Competition:** This is a two person team event. A team must have both players as graduates of the same service academy to be eligible to win this trophy. All other teams are eligible for all other places and recognition.
- 2) **Open Team Competition:** This is a two person team event. A team may both be graduates of the same service academy or from different academies, a graduate and guest or both guests to be eligible to win this trophy.
- 3) **The Challenge Trophy and Open Team Competition:** is *usually* played with **9 holes of Best Ball and 9 holes of Scramble** play. The declaration of Best Ball or Scramble for each hole is to be made *after* both players have hit their tee shots. However, teams may elect to play the entire event in the Scramble or Best Ball format. For those teams electing to play Best Ball for all 18 holes, a **Five Point Bonus** will be added to their team score. Teams electing to play all 18 holes in the Scramble format will have a **Four Points Deduction** from their team score.
- 4) **Individual Competition:** For golfers playing their own ball from tee to hole on all holes (Best Ball), achievement for Individual Excellence will be recognized.
- 5) **Contest holes: Longest Drive, Closest to the Pin and others TBA.**
- 6) **Mulligans:** Each golfer will be issued one *restricted* mulligan upon registration. This ball may be used to replace one totally unsatisfactory shot *from the tee* at the player's option. Each golfer may purchase up to two *unrestricted* mulligans upon registration. *Unrestricted* mulligans may be used to replace *any shot* at any time during the round. However, the mulligan shot may not be used to win a longest drive or closest to the pin or any other award. Unrestricted mulligans may only be purchased upon registration.
- 7) **A “modified” Stableford Point System:** The point system of scoring will be used and is further defined below. Points are won by a player (Team) on each hole according to the table below. Score for the round is simply the sum of all points won on each hole. Quicker play is facilitated since there is no value in playing a hole beyond the score of a double bogey (no points awarded).
- 8) **Tally your raw and “points” scores before turning in your scorecard!!** Failure to turn in a scorecard with both raw and “points” score will result in a 5 point penalty.

**Ties:** Ties will be broken by matching score cards starting with number one handicap hole and moving through to the eighteenth handicap hole.

**9) Scoring:**

<b>1 Point -Double Bogey</b>	<b>3 Points - Bogey</b>
<b>4 Points - Par</b>	<b>6 Points - Birdie</b>
<b>9 Points - Eagle</b>	<b>12 Points - Albatross</b>
