

25th Annual All Academy Golf Challenge
The Ken Kronlund Classic, 21 July 2017 *Rules*

- 1) **Challenge Trophy Team Competition:** This is a two person team event. A team must have both players as graduates of the same service academy to be eligible to win this trophy.
- 2) **Open Team Competition:** This is a two person team event. A team may be graduates of different academies, a graduate and guest or both guests to be eligible to win this trophy.
- 3) **The Challenge Trophy and Open Team Competition:** is *usually* played with **9 holes of Best Ball and 9 holes of Scramble** play. The declaration of Best Ball or Scramble for each hole is to be made *after* both players have hit their tee shots. Teams may elect to play the entire event in the Scramble or Best Ball format. Teams playing Best Ball for all 18 holes, receive a **Five Point Bonus** added to their score. Teams playing all 18 holes as a Scramble will have **Four Points Deducted** from their score.
- 4) **Individual Competition:** Golfers playing their own ball from tee to hole on all holes (Best Ball), will be recognized Individual Excellence.
- 5) **Contest holes: Longest Drive, Closest to the Pin and others TBA.**
- 6) **Mulligans:** Each golfer will be issued one *restricted* mulligan upon registration. This ball may be used to replace one shot *from the tee* at the player's option. Each golfer may purchase up to two *unrestricted* mulligans upon registration. *Unrestricted* mulligans may be used to replace *any shot* at any time during the round. The mulligan shot may not be used to win a longest drive or closest to the pin or any other contest or award. Unrestricted mulligans may only be purchased at registration.
- 7) **"Modified" Stableford Point System:** Points are won by a player (Team) on each hole according to the table below. Score for the round is simply the sum of all points won on each hole. Quicker play is facilitated since there is no value in playing a hole beyond the score of a double bogey (no points awarded).

8) Tally your “raw” and “points” scores before turning in your scorecard!! Failure to turn in a scorecard with both raw and “points” score will result in a 5 point penalty.

Ties: Ties will be broken by matching score cards starting with number one handicap hole and moving through to the eighteenth handicap hole.

9) Scoring:

1 Point -Double Bogey	3 Points - Bogey
4 Points - Par	6 Points - Birdie
9 Points - Eagle	12 Points - Albatross
