- Board Member Reports & Updates
 - Treasurer Patty has moved into the role of Treasurer and reports that the club remains fiscally sound. Most excess names have been removed from the account. Discussion followed regarding Grant Coupons (\$10 each) to be distributed in Boodle Boxes for Plebes, Yuks and Cows in the future.

Action: Patty will continue to follow up with removing no longer relevant names from the account and will add a 2021 parent co-signor. Kathy O will send information to Patty regarding purchasing Grant Coupons. Club will front the cost of the coupons (\$750) and be reimbursed by member donations for Boodle.

Events - Mike and Val Evans are now the Event Coordinators and have requested information from members regarding upcoming events.

Founders Day - 3/24/18 Army/Navy Baseball at Fenway - 4/20/18 6:00pm Hail and Farewell - 6/16/18 (tentative) 10 - 12

Action: Any member with information regarding upcoming events, please forward to Mike and Val. Alan will suggest a location for parents to gather prior to A/N baseball game at Fenway. He will also place the order for a block of tickets after members purchase through Paypal on Club Website. Mike E will secure a venue, possibly St Mary's Church in Shrewsbury for the Hail and Farewell. Exact location will be determined. We will need 2 - 4 cadets to speak with Cadet Candidates. \$100 donation will be made to the venue.

Transportation - We will stay with the same bus company although it is \$350 more per trip. The 40 person bus is difficult to break even, but we can look into using the 25 person bus in the Fall, based on need. Sonja Loar will be the Check-in contact in Newton.

Membership - Vin provided a detailed Membership Profile and suggestions for increasing Membership in the future.

If we average 23 cadets a year at a 66% participation rate at \$150 per cadet that would generate \$2,250 in membership fees a year.

Going forward I believe we will continue to have a higher membership rate with the one-time, life-time fee structure as you can see by the 90% participation rate.

It will be very important to create an environment where joining the WPPC-MA is the next step and appropriate thing to do once your DS/DD decides to become a cadet.

I think we should emphasize joining at the "Hail and Farewell" gathering and even provide the ability to enroll that day.

I know some will not make it through Beast but we do offer a money back arrangement for those situations.

Action - Plan for "Membership Drive" at Hail and Farewell with payment made that day

Firstie Gifts - Kathy researched cost of West Point Silver Dollars - \$25 without "W" stamp, \$56 with "W" stamp. US Capital Flag cost remains the same as previous years. Suggestion made by Bill Rapp to give Challenge Coin (WP Crest one side, WPPCMA on reverse), rather than Silver Coin. Much discussion followed regarding options.

Action - Bill will research cost and options for Challenge Coin and report back ASAP.* Vote was taken and Club will give Challenge Coin if possible, with the "W" stamped Silver Dollar as the fall-back option.
