Tips for New Cadet Candidate Families

In fact, make your reservation as soon as you know the event date. There is a limited amount of hotel rooms in the West Point area (and even up to 20 miles away) and they sell out fast. This hotel is convenient to public game day transportation, and is close to many great restaurants/bars to celebrate after the game. Our block of rooms are for Friday and Sat nights. The club negotiated rate is \$209 per room per night (plus tax), which is much less than current local hotel rates for that weekend.
