#### 6. Amy-Navy Hotel (Alan)

- Scheduled for Saturday, December 11th in New Jersey
  - We have 50 rooms secured at the Embassy Suites in Secaucus-Meadowlands
  - Double room \$189 & Suite room \$209 (double occupancy)
  - \$10 charge for each additional person, each night
     Friday, December 10<sup>th</sup> 4pm check-in

  - o This includes parking, shuttle to the game, and breakfast
  - An email with details for reserving your room(s) will be forthcoming
  - Please note that ROOM PRIORITY is given to paid members
- **Extra information:** 
  - o It is mandatory that all cadets go to the game; their uniform is their "ticket in"
  - West Point will provide a bus that takes them to and from the game on Saturday
  - In the past, parents were able to pick the cadets up on Friday and drive them down for the game. The cadets are also able to stay with you in the hotel and you will be able to drive them back to West Point on Sunday after the game.
  - o There are normally events on Friday and Saturday around the area. However, this is a new location and not sure what events will be happening
  - Usually, the WPPC-MA try to get together Friday night at a local bar. Breakfast in hotel is also an option for parents to get together

  - o Your cadet has the opportunity to purchase up to 4 tickets for the game, which are normally available in the Spring. Please contact your cadet.
  - You can also purchase tickets directly from West Point earlier if you make a donation to the Army A Club, we will send more information on this as well
